If you have not booked your ACCOMMODATION yet I would stronglyrecommend that you do so NOW!!

You will need to book your own accommodation through Getaway Golf. Australia. There is a separate accommodation booking form so get this completed and send it to Kristy

To simplify the accommodation we have booked a number of studio, 2 bedroom and 3 bedroom apartments. All rates include breakfast on Saturday and Sunday only.

The Studio apartments are suitable for those golfers bringing a partner and this will cost you \$210 per night (ie. \$105 per person per night).

The 2 bedroom villa will be set up to have 3 golfers—2 sharing a room and the other in a single room. If you're sharing it'll cost you \$95 per night and if you chose to have a room on your own then you'll pay a little premium, but it will only cost you \$125 per night.

The 3 bedroom villa, however, is suitable to for 5 golfers—2 rooms with 2 golfers sharing and a single room for that golfer that finds it difficult to share (a nice way of saying "he snores too much"). Again, it's \$95 twin share and \$125 going solo.
